We are so excited for our annual SADA summer recital. We are excited to announce that this year we will have 3 shows! All of our Twinkle Star Dancers (Ages 2-3, 3-4 and 4-5) will perform in our 1st or 2nd show "SHOWTIME!" Showtime! gives dancers enrolled in Twinkle Babies and Twinkle Stars classes the chance to show their friends and families what they have learned with a performance at the end of the dance season. For many students, this may be their first time ever being on stage! The Twinkle Program is designed to promote self-confidence in young children and getting on stage at the end of the year is a critical part of the program.

Participation in the summer dance recital is not mandatory; it is strongly encouraged and is considered an important part of the overall dance experience. Dancing is a performing art and the performance is the highlight of a dancer's experience, something for them to look forward to and to strive for. Being part of a performance helps build self-esteem and self-confidence and gives students a chance to showcase the results of all of their hard work, dedication, and progress.

All of our students, regardless of level, are invited to perform in our annual recital.

The rehearsal process is also a tremendous learning experience as well. It helps the children develop retention skills, and by working with their classmates on a group performance, they learn the positive aspects of working as a team to create the best end result.

Recital Fee-

The recital fee is \$60/dancer. The recital fee covers: 2 - \$10.00 tickets (eligible for upgrade), student recital t-shirt, souvenir program book and venue costs (auditorium rental, custodian fee, sound and tech. operator fee, music licensing, and insurance protection.) Recital fee for additional family members- \$35.00 per student.

Our recital ticketing is online **reserved** seating instead of the general admission method we have used in the past. Each family will receive (2) \$ 10.00 tickets free of charge, to the show of your choice. - Rehearsal time for "SHOWTIME!" Show 1: 4:30-5:30pm
- Rehearsal time for "SHOWTIME!" Show 2: 5:30-6:30 pm
- Rehearsal time for "LA LA LAND" and Daddy/Daughter: 6:30 8:30pm
- Students will be dismissed after they rehearse/perform.
- Please have dancers dressed in dance attire with appropriate shoes. Parents are allowed to video record and take photos (no flash photography as this is a distraction to the dancers on stage) of the performance at the **rehearsal only**
- During the rehearsal students may sit in the auditorium and watch the other performances. If you bring siblings with you to the rehearsal, please have another adult with you to watch him or her. Rehearsal can be hectic at times and we want to prevent distractions to the performers.

Recital Day- Saturday, June 15th 2019
SHOWTIME! Show 1: Starts @ 10:00 am
SHOWTIME! Show 2: Starts @ 12:30 pm
LA LA LAND Starts @ 3:30 pm
Doors Open for Seating 30 minutes prior to start of each show

- SHOWTIME! Dancers in Show #1 need to arrive promptly @ 9:00 am with hair and make-up done.
- SHOWTIME! Dancers in Show #2 need to arrive promptly @ 11:30 with hair and make-up done.
- *LA LA LAND Dancers need to arrive promptly @ 2:00 pm with hair and make-up done.
- Dancers must wear street clothes into the auditorium.
- When you arrive, dancer(s) and one parent can proceed to the Dancer/Performer check-in table
 to check in. Once you are checked -in, you may go to your assigned dressing room (separated
 by routine) and meet up with your class mom volunteer. Parent must have their show ticket to
 enter w/child
- Only 1 parent is allowed in the dressing room with each dancer.
- Once you are in the dressing room start dressing your dancer in her costume. <u>Dancers are</u>
 NOT permitted in the auditorium until after they perform,
- Dancers will be taken to the dressing room after they perform with the class mom volunteer. The
 parent who checked the dancer in will need to pick up their child from the dressing room and
 return to the auditorium for the rest of the show.
- Make sure your child eats a light lunch/dinner or snack before arriving. Dancers will not be permitted to eat during the show
- Doors open to attending guest(s), 30 minutes before show. Reserved seating can be purchased online. Guest(s) will not be allowed in early.
- Video recording and Flash Photography is strictly prohibited during the recital.

WHAT TO BRING TO RECITAL

- Costume
- Dance Shoes
- Extra hair supplies to touch up: hairspray, bobby pins, etc.
- Make Up for touch ups: eye shadow, blush, lip stick/gloss, etc.
- Water/Snacks
- Blanket to set on the floor for dancer to sit/rest. Quiet, clean activities to keep students occupied during their wait. (ex. coloring supplies, reading books, cards, ipad/ipod, etc.)

- ★ Ballet Routine- High Bun
- ★ Tap Routine- High Pony Tail (Curled) on the crown of the head
- ★ Jazz Routine- High Pony Tail (Curled) on the crown of the head
- ★ Hip Hop Routine- High Pony Tail (Curled) on the crown of the head

Performance Make Up Guide

(Stage Makeup is highly recommended but not mandatory)

Red Lipstick, Cream Eye Shadow on lid, Dark Brown on the outside of the eyelid, black eyeliner (older dancers) pink/rose blush
